
AFSC and Alberta Feeder Association Information Sharing

Objective: For AFSC to allow Alberta Feeder Associations (FA) access to Western Livestock Price Insurance Program (WLPIP) information for specific clients and enable Feeder Associations to pay premium on client's behalf.

Information Sharing:

In order to allow the Feeder Association access to client's WLPIP information, AFSC has created an 'AFSC relationship' the FA can take on for their clients called the 'WLPIP Information Contact'. As a WLPIP Information Contact, FA staff will then have the ability to ask AFSC directly about WLPIP premium owed for specific client policies.

Client Requirement:

The client will need to complete:

- AB Consent for Release of Information to Third Party
 - Recipient: the applicable local Alberta Feeder Association

Feeder Association Requirement:

AFSC requires the FA to be setup as a Business registered in our data system. The Feeder Association will need to complete:

- AB Application for Identification Number - WLPIP;
 - Business Name: the applicable local Feeder Association
 - Contact Person: staff member who will work with WLPIP files
 - List local Feeder Association staff within the Applicant Details
 - Designated FA staff will need to be recorded in AFSC's system for verification purposes as part of the application

All forms must be submitted to AFSC before information will be shared with the Feeder Association.
